Red Rock Elementary School Athletics Acknowledgement of Rules and Terms for Participation

Participating in the Red Rock Elementary School Athletic Program is a privilege. If the student-athlete cannot represent their team, themselves, and their school in a respectable manner, this privilege will be taken away. In order to reach the team's full potential, the individual will be responsible to abide by the following conditions.

- All participants are students first and athletes second. This means if a student cannot perform in the classroom, they cannot perform on the field/court. If a student receives an in-school suspension, they will be ineligible to play in their next game. If a student receives a second in-school suspension, or out-of-school suspension, they may be suspended indefinitely from the team.
- Athletes must meet the school's academic requirements
 - Each athlete must maintain passing grades in all classes. Progress reports will be conducted for all student athletes during the sports seasons.
 - Parents/Guardians, student athletes, and administration will all work together to develop a plan to improve student grades, which may include suspension from the team until grades improve.
- Attendance at all practice and games is mandatory. Doctors, parents, or teachers may excuse athletes if done prior to an event. Athletes must present a written letter to their coach, or have a parent call a coach, to excuse their child.
- Athletes and their parents must demonstrate sportsmanship during all competitions/games. Any display of unsportsmanlike conduct will result in consequence.
 - 1st occurrence = Verbal reprimand from coach or athletic director.
 - 2nd occurrence = Must sit the bench for a period of time during activity.
 - \circ 3rd occurrence = Athlete is suspended for at least one game.
 - 4th occurrence = Athlete is dismissed from sport and must turn their uniform into the coach.
- Athletes must conduct themselves in a respectful manner at all times during away games. Any act of anger or disrespect toward a teammate, coach, opponent, official, or adult will result in a loss of playing time, and possibly suspension. This includes obeying the bus rules.
- No student may participate until they have been cleared through the athletic director.
- Parents, guardians, and family members conduct themselves in a positive manner, displaying sportsmanship at all athletic events. Please review the "Spectator Code of Conduct"
