A formal and comprehensive process is used to design and implement a system-wide K-8 educational programming that enables all students to learn at challenging levels. We strive to offer high quality curriculum resources that support evidence-based instructional practices in our classrooms. All standards and programs are approved by the governing board.

Currently, the district is undergoing a K-8 English Language Arts revision and adoption. A team of educators and Link to resources administration will be working collaboratively over two years to create a curriculum framework for ELA based on Arizona’s English Language Arts Standards.
