



Back-to-School Immunization Appointments



In preparation for back-to-school and to ensure that we continue taking proactive measures in reducing the spread of COVID-19, Pinal County Public Health Clinics will be scheduling immunization appointments in advance.

Effective Monday, May 18th, the following Pinal County Public Health Clinics will remain open from 8:00 a.m.to 6:00 p.m. We will begin providing Immunization services by appointment only.

We kindly ask parents and students to **not** walk in during this time. Instead, call our Central Appointment Desk at 866-960-0633 today to secure an appointment in any of the following Public Health Clinics below:

Follow these steps to make sure your child is ready for school:
1. Schedule your child's visit early before school starts at 1-866-960-0633. Avoid the backto-school rush and long wait times by scheduling an appointment today!
2. Talk to your child's health care provider and school about what vaccines your child needs. We recognize every child is different.
Before your appointment:
3. Be prepared with a mask for both you and your child/children 3 years old or older
4. Bring your child/children's Immunization (shot) Records.
5. Fill out and bring the immunization registration form (1 per each child), if possible. Having the form filled ahead of time will decrease the amount of time you are in our clinics. The form can be found on our website at Immunization Registration Form.
6. Provide a letter granting permission if someone other than a parent/legal guardian will be bringing your child/children in place of you. The letter should include: child's name, date of birth, your name, signature, phone number and date.
